## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



### What the program rules?

Core expectations include a commitment to recovery, employment or access to legally derived income, attendance at weekly house meetings and commitment to community living (e.g., cleanliness, chores, yardwork, etc.). A handbook can be provided on request.

### What is the program fee?

Single- \$160, Double - \$145, Triple- \$130, Double w/ Private Bath - \$155 (DH only), Studio- \$200 (DH only). The program fee covers cost of room, heat, hot water, electricity, YouTube T.V., and access to a washer and dryer.

### Do you have basic needs beds?

Yes, we have 3 male and 2 female beds funded by ABH. Those beds can be used at any of our three houses.

### Do you allow medical marijuana?

We permit tablet form only, with a valid prescription is permitted but must remain locked on premise.

### Do you allow residents to be on prescribed controlled medication?

Yes. Residents on controlled medication, to include MAT, are required to utilize Staff Mates which includes keeping their medication locked.

**Do you allow animals?** We do not. At present, Wilson House has a resident housecat.
