Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) is a highly effective evidence-based treatment for opioid use disorders. Our **Mobile MAT Van** provides immediate connection to buprenorphine, also known as Suboxone for individuals in Windham and Tolland County. This life saving prescription medication has been shown to reduce drug overdose deaths and improve treatment outcomes. The van provides an array of additional services to include Peer Support.

- Access to Suboxone treatment
- Access to Naloxone and training
- Recovery and Peer Support Services
- Linkages to treatment resources
- HIV/HCV testing and services
- Safer Use Supplies (e.g. Fentanyl testing kits, wound care kits, syringes and condoms
