FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the program rules? Core expectations include a commitment to recovery, employment or access to legally derived income, attendance at weekly house meetings and commitment to community living (e.g., cleanliness, chores, yardwork, etc.).

Do you have basic needs beds? PPI has 3 male and 2 female beds funded by ABH.

What is the program fee? The weekly program fee is as follows: Single- \$160, Double - \$145, Triple- \$130, Double w/ Private Bath - \$155, Studio- \$200. The program fee includes bedroom access, heat, hot water, electricity, YouTube T.V., and laundry facilities.

Do you allow medical marijuana? We permit medical marijuana in tablet form with a prescription and require it be kept locked when on premise.

Do you allow residents to be on controlled medication? Yes. Residents on controlled medication, to include MAT, are connected to Staff Mates who works with them to ensure controlled medications are kept locked.

Do you allow animals? We do not. However, Wilson House has a resident house cat.
