SSI/SSDI Outreach, Access & Recovery (SOAR)

SSI/SSDI Outreach, Access, and Recovery (SOAR) designed to increase access to the disability income benefit programs administered by the Social Security Administration (SSA) for eligible adults who are experiencing or at risk of homelessness and have a serious mental illness, medical impairment, and/or a co-occurring substance use disorder.

The Eastern Region Service Center (ERSC) provides outreach, engagement and case management services to help individuals with substance abuse disorders in Connecticut's Eastern Region.
