### WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT

Our caring team of recovery specialists' will assist you in developing a plan to successfully transition back to the community. You will be connected to a Transitional Case Manager (TCM) who will work with you prior to release to develop a re-entry plan that will address housing, recovery supports, medical and behavioral health care, employment, education/training, and connection to family. Post release, your TCM will work closely with you to support you in meeting your goals for up to four months.

### REFERRAL CRITERIA AND ADMISSION

Individuals eligible for enrollment are those with a history of substance use disorder and/or behavioral health diagnosis scheduled for release within 3 months or those with a release date of six or fewer months from the date of admission. Individuals must agree to all program requirements prior to admission.
